Look at the map of Melbourne Zoo. Choose the best word for each sentence.

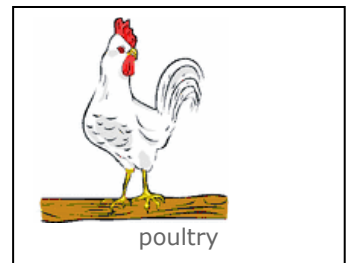
1. The kangaroos are *above / between / next to* the emus.
